## Test Window

You can start your test any time within the test time window of 15 hours. However, your test duration remains the same, that is, 3 hours. Hence, if you start at 8:30 PM, your test ends at 11:30 PM. But remember folks, your test will get auto-submitted when the test window ends. Since your test window is 9 AM to 11:59 PM, it is advisable to start test between 9 AM to 9 PM. If you start at 10:30 PM, you will only have 89 minutes to complete the test.



# FAQs

## 1. Who can register for Pre-JEE Main Test?

All students of classes 12 and 12+ that have purchased a myPAT course or are FIITJEE students and are targeting JEE Main can register.

## 2. Is there any registration fee?

No, there is no registration fee for the Pre-JEE Main Test Series if you have purchased a myPAT course or if you are a FIITJEE student.

## 3. Will the test series be conducted online or offline?

These tests will be conducted as an online examination to resemble the JEE Main examination experience. It will have the same screen, difficulty level and marking scheme as that of the real JEE Main examination.

#### 4. How can I prepare for Pre-JEE Main Tests?

You can prepare by attempting concept tests and full tests on myPAT. Additionally, myPAT also has multiple webinars, ebooks and other free preparation resources which will be sent you via email over the next 30 days.

#### 5. What is the syllabus?

The Pre-JEE Main Tests shall cover the complete JEE Main syllabus.

#### 6. What is the difference between test window and test duration?

The test window is the time interval within which you can attempt the test. The test duration is the time duration of the test. For example, if test window is 9 AM – 11:59 PM, you can start the test any time within the test time window of 15 hours. However, your test duration remains the same, that is, 3 hours.

#### 7. How do I start the test?

Log in to your myPAT account on the day of the test.

1. Select 'Assignments' from the menu bar.
2. Set your goal (on the menu bar) to JEE(M) - 2019.
3. Select 'Upcoming Tests' on the right panel.
4. Click on 'Attempt Test' button to begin the tes

#### 8. When will the results be announced?

The results shall be announced within a week of the test date.
